





THEOLOGY AFTER EINSTEIN **with Rt. Revd. Peter Forster, Bishop of Chester**

The Rt. Revd. Peter Forster, Bishop of Chester will be speaking on "Theology after Einstein," looking at the revolutionary and often ill-understood implications of Einstein's thought and the fascinating way they interact with Christian faith. This will include the post-Einsteinian concept of 'the universe', the movement from mechanism to field theory and its relation to space-time, the arrow of time, cosmic and human uniqueness, and Jesus Christ, Light of the World, a unique and universal Saviour. This promises to be an exciting and thought-provoking evening.

Rt. Revd. Peter Forster was formerly senior tutor at St. John's College, Durham and Vicar of Beverley Minster. He is admirably equipped to speak on the relation of science and Christianity with a degree in chemistry from Oxford University, as well as a BD and Ph.D. (on Irenaeus' Doctrine of Creation) from Edinburgh University. He has published on the relation of theology and science, and has a long-standing interest in the thought of the theoretician of science Michael Polanyi (author of Personal Knowledge and The Tacit Dimension).
